

# WINE LIST

## SPARKLING @ \$50

- 223 2015 Reginato Cestina Rosé of Malbec *método tradicional* (Mendoza, Argentina)  
Crisp and dry with lovely strawberry, rhubarb flavors and aromas.
- 230 2013 Jané Ventura Brut Nature Reserva de la Musica, Cava (Penedes, Spain)  
Good carbonic release with small and persistent bubbles. Clean and frank flavours of aging together with fresh fruit. Good balance. It is dry, subtle and fresh. A broad and persistent finish.
- 225 N.V. Taittinger Brut La Francaise (Reims, France Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier)  
After resting until the end of winter, the wine is blended, and then the final cuvée undergoes a second fermentation in the bottle aging on the lees for almost 4 years. \$70.

## WHITE WINES @ \$50

- 302 2014 Bokisch - Albariño (Clements Hills, Lodi, CA)  
Juicy and fruity with flavors of pear, McIntosh apple, pink grapefruit and a hint of lychee, it pairs beautifully with shellfish and seafood.
- 336 2015 Don Jacobo - White Rioja 100% Viura (Rioja, Spain)  
Clean and crisp acidity balances the big fruit core of this wine. As is traditional in white Rioja there is also some oak influence but it has been well integrated into the wine.
- 345 2013 Flux Blanc - Blend (Napa Valley, CA 82% Grenache Blanc, 18% Roussanne)  
A juicy, voluptuous white offering flavors and aromas of Bosch pear, guava, pineapple and lychee. The mouth is dramatically rich and broad, with front palate acidity, rich Roussanne in the mid-palate, and a hint of tannin from the Grenache Blanc.
- 447 2014 Giró del Gorner, Barrica, (oaked) - Xarel·lo (Penedès, Catalunya Spain)  
Here, the principal grape used in CAVA production is fermented as a still wine in oak, with lees aging, to an amazing effect. Elegant and balanced, a lush and aromatic tropical island ambiance envelops the palate with toasty, vanilla tinged opulence.
- 301 2013 Zocker, Niven Family Wine Estates - Riesling (Paragon Vineyard, Edna Valley, CA)  
A refreshing, vibrant presence, rich texture, and complex flavors of honey, citrus and apple are all laced with terroir-driven minerality in near-addictive measure.
- 401 2014 Balthasar Ress "Von Unserm" Trocken Riesling (Rheingau S.W. Germany)  
In 1870, Balthasar Ress began making wine for his family in the Rheingau. Five generations later, the estate's wines Von Unserm or "Our Own" gained international recognition, and proprietor Christian Ress has furthered their legacy. This dry (Trocken) Riesling delivers a beautiful dose of crisp apple, earth and rich minerality.
- 334 2015 Travis - Chardonnay (Santa Barbara, CA)  
This is pure, rich, fresh and complex Chardonnay, with perfectly integrated use of oak and very little malolactic conversion. Voluptuous with flavors of terroir and bright chardonnay fruit over a crisp mineral core.
- 322 2014 Moana Park - Chardonnay (Hawke's Bay, New Zealand)  
Fragrant yellow stonefruit aromas melded with a layer of nutty oak with toasty and mineral detail. Medium-full bodied, bright and lively fruit flavours are entwined with nutty oak, toasty elements and minerally suggestions. The mouthfeel is lush, with subtly creamy barrel-ferment richness providing good presence.
- 333 2011 Viña Acquitania Sol de Sol - Chardonnay (Traiguén, Malleco Valley, Chile)  
With perfect integration of oak, the plush and expansive body holds treasures of ripe melon, roasted peach, mineral and vanilla, very similar to a burgundy.
- 420 Maior de Mendoza - Albarino (Salnes Valley, Rias Bixas, Spain)  
This wine has it all, it is clean, with plenty of apples, minerality, and a briny finish.
- 449 2013 Pardas Rupestris Blanco (Penedès, Spain Macabeo, Malvasía, Xarel·lo, & Xarel·lo Rojo)  
These are the four indigenous Catalan varieties typically used to make CAVA, the sparkling wine of Penedès. This is a bright wine with white flower and stone fruit ripeness nicely enhanced by tart citrus notes and the ever-present streak of limestone minerality.

## WHITE WINES @ \$65

- 332 2013 Wanless - Wisner Vineyard Chardonnay (Livermore, CA)  
10 months sur lie aging, 100% malolactic fermentation provides an excellent balance of acidity and the chardonnay fruit. As close to a French Burgundy as one can get.
- 335 2014 Sante Arcangeli - Chardonnay (Santa Cruz Mountains, CA)  
Split Rail Vineyard. Minerality with balanced tropical fruit and strong acidity, nuances of chamomile aromas.

## ROSÉ WINES @ \$50

- 509 2014 Jeff Cohn Iris - Blend (California 60% Grenache, 20% Mourvèdre, 20% Syrah)  
The bouquet is all strawberry (no sugar added, of course), and the first sip confirms the impression. This is a middleweight, but like the best of them, light on its feet with some spice that'll keep you intrigued glass after glass.
- 512 2015 Selby - Syrah Blend (Sonoma County 50% Syrah 25% Grenache 25% Mourvedre)  
Extremely limited production, here is an elegant showcase of polish and vivacity in a rosé of distinctive charm. Delicate in the mouth, look for nuances of rose petals and citrus.
- 635 2015 J.A. Jofré Vinos Frios del Año Rosado - Blend (Curico, Chile 50% Petit Verdot, 50% Garnacha)  
The grapes are vinified like whites, with almost no skin contact. He harvests early to get all that freshness in the wine. Minerality, acidity, floral fruit and a roundness to the palate.
- 635 2016 Sante Arcangeli - Rose of Pinot Noir (Santa Cruz Mountains, CA)  
Crisp with wild strawberry and hibiscus notes with some underlying pinot noir earthiness.

## PINOT NOIR @ \$60

- 701 **2014 Elizabeth Rose** (*Yountville, Napa Valley, CA*)  
Burgundian in style, this unique Yountville Pinot is bursting with flavor. An elegant wine with a beautiful balance of earth and fruit. On the palate, ripe raspberry with spicy undertones. Bright mouth-feel with notes of morel mushroom and forest floor qualities.
- 701 **2013 Champ de Rêves** (*Anderson Valley, CA*)  
Vibrant blueberry-strawberry fruit intertwines with aromas of dark-red rose, maple, licorice, and toasted hazelnut. On the palate, juicy raspberry, dark cocoa, and pennyroyal flavors emerge. Delicately-balanced acidity and minerality lead into a firmly structured finish.
- 710 **2014 Royal Prince** (*Bien Nacido, Santa Maria Valley, Sta. Barbara County, CA*)  
The 2014 shows balance and richness with aromas dried cherries, Dijon mustard, violets, strawberries and baking spices.
- 717 **2012 Rued** (*Russian River Valley, Sonoma, CA*)  
Bright fruit aromas of blackberry and raspberry with subtle hints of caramel and dried herbs. On the palate, lush flavors of Bing cherry, raspberry, and Santa Rosa plum with notes of vanilla and thyme. Perfect acidity and soft tannins leave a well-structured and smooth mouth feel.
- 715 **2015 Espino** (*Maipo Valley, Chile*)  
Both Victor Pino and William Fevre are an important part of the wine tapestry since early 1960 in both continents. The Wine: Pacific Ocean and volcanic soil are very present with flavors and texture. Taste: ranges from cherries to dark olives with orange blossoms in the nose.

## RED WINES @ \$40

- 722 **2014 Bodega Garzon-Tannat** (*Uruguay*)  
This wine exhibits a mix of red and black fruit with hints of white pepper and spice; soft tannins.
- 778 **2014 Heho, Domaine les Hautes Noëllles - Blend** (*Loire, France, 45% Grolleau Noir, 45% Gamay, 10% Cabernet Franc*)  
With ripe red fruit and a peppery nose, the balanced palate shows sufficient acidity, structure and soft tannins.
- 810 **2014 Senda, Bodegas y Vinedos - Mencia** (*Bierzo, Leon, NW 80% Mencia; 10% Palomino; 10% Dona Blanca*)  
Great minerality and depth of flavors, it brims with a purity of structure, juicy freshness, and a kiss of Atlantic sea air coming through.
- 741 **2014 Mayu Carménère - Syrah** (*Elqui Valley, Chile 55% Carménère, 45% Syrah*)  
Smooth on the palate, a perfect balance of body, soft tannins and subtle oak character envelope the concentration of fruit.
- 832 **2014 Tomero- Cabernet Sauvignon** (*Mendoza, Argentina*)  
Aromas of ripe red fruits and spices such as licorice, sweet pepper, cumin and notes of tobacco and chocolate.  
Good body and sweet, robust tannins.

## RED WINES @ \$50

- 738 **2014 Familia Mosso - Malbec** (*Lujan de Cuyo, Mendoza, Argentina*)  
Since 1910 their wine production is focused on high quality old vines and estate production. Their wines will remind you of Oak Knoll with a solid back bone, dusty white pepper and dry cherry.
- 787 **2013 Koden, Luis Alegre-Tempranillo** (*Rioja, Spain*)  
A "semi-Crianza" of 100% Tempranillo, this is a refreshing, easy-drinking, deliciously fresh red, only showing a touch of rounded spice at the very end. It is bright cherry-red in color, with aromas of even riper cherries and wild herbs.
- 857 **2014 Aljibes Cabernet Franc** (*La Mancha, Spain*)  
Rare in Spain, this Cab Franc opens with an elegant bouquet of ripe, rich dark fruits, minerals & floral components. Powerful in the mouth, its mature fruits highlight the softness of the ripe tannins & unique hints of spice.
- 863 **2012 Stage Left Cellars The Breadwinner Syrah Blend** (*Central Coast, CA 62% Syrah, 27% Grenache, 11% Mourvedre*)  
Pomegranate, raspberry, wild strawberry, hints of smoke and stone, and Grenache spice on the long finish and soft tannins.
- 780 **2013 Selby - Grenache** (*Dry Creek Valley, California*)  
Bold flavors of cassis and cherry with notes of clove and nutmeg. Great acidity with soft tannins.
- 786 **2012 Cantos de Valpiedra Rioja** (*Rioja, Spain 100% Tempranillo*)  
Aromas of black fruit with vanilla and mineral nuances. On the palate it is rich, concentrated and elegant with flavors of ripe fruit.
- 860 **2013 Vistalba - Malbec Blend** (*Mendoza, Argentina Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Bonarda*)  
Lively and vibrant red fruits, smooth, velvety tannins, and hints of cocoa complement the good body and lengthy, elegant finish.
- 861 **2011 Herdade do Esporão Red Reserva** (*Alentejo, Portugal Alicante Bouschet, Aragonez, Trincadeira & Cabernet*)  
Esporão estate history goes back to the XIII century. Their reserva shows its unique blend of terroir exposed to the Atlantic breeze. Full body, ripe intense red and black fruit, dark cocoa and a very long finish. 12 months in oak.

## RED WINES OVER \$80

- 835 **2012 Tonti Family Wines-Old Vine Zinfandel** (*Russian River Valley, CA*)  
Bright dark opaque garnet blue color with flavors of black raspberries, candied violets, bramble, with a touch of pepper. Tannic, crisp, dry full body and a warming. Complex, medium-length finish with firm tannins and moderate oak. \$90
- 848 **2014 Trefethen Dragon's Tooth-Malbec Blend** (*Napa Valley, CA 45% Malbec, 35% Petit Verdot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon*)  
Aromas of blackberry and cracked pepper, with hints of cinnamon and other baking spices. The palate features flavors of red currant and wood smoke leading to a long, elegant finish. \$90\*
- 790 **2014 Lail "Blueprint" Cabernet Sauvignon** (*Napa Valley, CA 95% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Petit Verdot*) \$140\*  
The name says it all—a schematic for greatness in a bottle! With fruit sourced from six premium vineyards, this gorgeous cuvée shows a gracious approach, with ripe, blackcurrant fruit and licorice, a subtle hint of oak, silky tannins, and full-bodied opulence. But there's a youthful kick of exuberance that focuses the wine's intensity, disclosing layer upon layer of sumptuous complexity.
- 792 **2010 Dry Creek Vineyard Mariner Meritage - Magnum** (*Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma Cty, CA*) \$160\*  
41% Cabernet Sauvignon, 41% Merlot, 7% Malbec, 6% Cabernet Franc, 5% Petit Verdot Opulent texture and ever-deepening layers of complex, juicy flavors in a smooth and seductive body.
