

WINE LIST

SPARKLING @ \$48

- 230 2013 YÁ Cuvée 23 Brut Reserva, Cava (Penedes, Spain)
Good carbonic release with small and persistent bubbles. Clean and frank flavours of aging together with fresh fruit. Good balance. It is dry, subtle and fresh. A broad and persistent finish.
- 231 Keush Origins Méthode Traditionelle Brut, (Armenia)
Keush is a pioneer in making a Méthode Traditionelle sparkling wine from indigenous Armenian grape varieties-the result is an explosion of crispness and freshness.

WHITE WINES @ \$50

- 336 2015 Don Jacobo - White Rioja 100% Viura (Rioja, Spain)
Clean and crisp acidity balances the big fruit core of this wine. As is traditional in white Rioja there is also some oak influence but it has been well integrated into the wine.
- 303 2015 Rodney Strong Sauvignon Blanc-Charlotte's Home (Sonoma Valley, CA)
Light, crisp, aromatic with citrus, peach, and tropical fruits.
- 304 2015 Dominique Roger Sancerre, Domaine du Carrou - Sauvignon Blanc (Sancerre, France)
Citrus and peach aromas with a little box tree and gooseberry and some smoky, flinty seams. A good ripeness of plum and yellow peach fruit but not overdone, this is a classy and expressive Sauvignon Blanc.
- 345 2013 Flux Blanc - Blend (Napa Valley, CA 82% Granache Blanc, 18% Rousanne)
A juicy, voluptuous white offering flavors and aromas of Bosch pear, guava, pineapple and lychee. The mouth is dramatically rich and broad, with front palate acidity, rich Rousanne in the mid-palate, and a hint of tannin from the Grenache Blanc.
- 447 2014 Giró del Gorner, Barrica,(oaked) - Xarel·lo (Penedès, Catalunya Spain)
Here, the principal grape used in CAVA production is fermented as a still wine in oak, with lees aging, to an amazing effect. Elegant and balanced, a lush and aromatic tropical island ambience envelops the palate with toasty, vanilla tinged opulence.
- 301 2013 Zocker, Niven Family Wine Estates - Riesling (Paragon Vineyard, Edna Valley, CA)
A refreshing, vibrant presence, rich texture, and complex flavors of honey, citrus and apple are all laced with terroir-driven minerality in near-addictive measure.
- 401 2014 Balthasar Röss "Von Unserm" Trocken Riesling (Rheingau S.W. Germany)
This dry (Trocken) Riesling delivers a beautiful dose of crisp apple, earth and rich minerality.
- 330 2014 McIntyre - Estate Chardonnay (Santa Lucia Highlands, CA)
Fresh and vibrant, this Chardonnay possesses a zesty core of nectarine, key lime and guava. The palate is creamy and lush with a subtle blast of new French oak shining through the fruit. This memorable Chardonnay really captures the personality and character of our McIntyre Estate Vineyard.
- 334 2015 Travis - Chardonnay (Santa Barbara, CA)
This is pure, rich, fresh and complex Chardonnay, with perfectly integrated use of oak and very little malolactic conversion. Voluptuous with flavors of terroir and bright chardonnay fruit over a crisp mineral core.
- 322 2014 Moana Park - Chardonnay (Hawke's Bay, New Zealand)
Fragrant yellow stonefruit aromas melded with a layer of nutty oak with toasty and mineral detail. Medium-full bodied, bright and lively fruit flavours are entwined with nutty oak, toasty elements and minerally suggestions. The mouthfeel is lush, with subtly creamy barrel-ferment richness providing good presence.
- 333 2011 Viña Acquitania Sol de Sol - Chardonnay (Traiguén, Malleco Valley, Chile)
With perfect integration of oak, the plush and expansive body holds treasures of ripe melon, roasted peach, mineral and vanilla, very similar to a burgundy.
- 420 Maior de Mendoza - Albarino (Salnes Valley, Rias Bixas, Spain)
This wine has it all, it is clean, with plenty of apples, minerality, and a briny finish.

WHITE WINES @ \$65

- 332 2013 Wanless - Wisner Vineyard Chardonnay (Livermore, CA)
10 months sur lie aging, 100% malolactic fermentation provides an excellent balance of acidity and the chardonnay fruit. As close to a French Burgundy as one can get.
- 335 2014 Sante Arcangeli - Chardonnay (Santa Cruz Mountains, CA)
Split Rail Vineyard. Minerality with balanced tropical fruit and strong acidity, nuances of chamomile aromas.
- 337 2015 Defaix Chablis 1er Cru Vaillons - Chardonnay (Chablis, France)
Harmonious with freshness (good acidity), structure, minerality and floral aromas.
- 338 2014 Lioco La Marisma Chardonnay (Santa Cruz Mountains, CA)
Aromas of nectarine pit, rock salt and pomelo with flavors of crushed stone, green papaya and sea urchin. \$80

ROSÉ WINES @ \$48

- 509 2015 Chateau de la Clapière Cru Classé - Côtes de Provence (France Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah)
Pepper and spice come through strongly in this lemon and red-fruit-flavored wine. It has a creamy texture cut through with tangy orange and red currants. The aftertaste is full while always fruity.
- 512 2015 Le Galantin Bandol - Mourvedre Blend (Bandol, France 50% Mourvedre 25% Grenache 25% Cinsault)
Fresh and dry with spices and summer fruit.
- 515 2015 Le Secret de Saint Pierre-Grenache, Cinsault (Côte de Provence, France)
Elegant pink-salmon color with a powerful nose of white peaches, candied apricots, guava, exotic fruit blossoms and a hint of spices. Great fullness in the mouth, a rich wine with great character and excellent aromatic length.
- 514 2016 Chateau Maris Old School - Grenache Blend (Minervois, France Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah)
Fresh, focused tropical fruits, honeysuckle, lemon rind, and buttered almonds on the nose. Nice minerality and a touch of muscle weight that balances the strawberry and orange zest notes.
- 516 2015 Solar de Ranz - Tempranillo Blend (Rioja, Spain Tempranillo, Grenache, Viura)
Great aromas and flavors of red fruit with a great depth of minerality.

PINOT NOIR @ \$60

- 701 **2013 Champ de Rêves** (*Anderson Valley, CA*)
Vibrant blueberry-strawberry fruit intertwines with aromas of dark-red rose, maple, licorice, and toasted hazelnut. On the palate, juicy raspberry, dark cocoa, and pennyroyal flavors emerge. Delicately-balanced acidity and minerality lead into a firmly structured finish.
- 710 **2014 Royal Prince** (*Bien Nacido, Santa Maria Valley, Sta. Barbara County, CA*)
The 2014 shows balance and richness with aromas dried cherries, Dijon mustard, violets, strawberries and baking spices.
- 717 **2012 Rued** (*Russian River Valley, Sonoma, CA*)
Bright fruit aromas of blackberry and raspberry with subtle hints of caramel and dried herbs. On the palate, lush flavors of Bing cherry, raspberry, and Santa Rosa plum with notes of vanilla and thyme. Perfect acidity and soft tannins leave a well-structured and smooth mouth feel.
- 715 **2015 Espino** (*Maipo Valley, Chile*)
Both Victor Pino and William Fevre are an important part of the wine tapestry since early 1960 in both continents. The Wine: Pacific Ocean and volcanic soil are very present with flavors and texture. Taste: ranges from cherries to dark olives with orange blossoms in the nose.

RED WINES @ \$40

- 722 **2014 Bodega Garzon-Tannat** (*Uruguay*)
This wine exhibits a mix of red and black fruit with hints of white pepper and spice; soft tannins.
- 810 **2014 Senda, Bodegas y Vinedos - Mencia** (*Bierzo, Leon, NW 80% Mencia; 10% Palomino; 10% Dona Blanca*)
Great minerality and depth of flavors, it brims with a purity of structure, juicy freshness, and a kiss of Atlantic sea air coming through.

RED WINES @ \$50

- 738 **2014 Familia Mosso - Malbec** (*Lujan de Cuyo, Mendoza, Argentina*)
Since 1910 their wine production is focused on high quality old vines and estate production. Their wines will remind you of Oak Knoll with a solid back bone, dusty white pepper and dry cherry.
- 787 **2013 Koden, Luis Alegre-Tempranillo** (*Rioja, Spain*)
A "semi-Crianza" of 100% Tempranillo, this is a refreshing, easy-drinking, deliciously fresh red, only showing a touch of rounded spice at the very end. It is bright cherry-red in color, with aromas of even riper cherries and wild herbs.
- 863 **2012 Stage Left Cellars The Breadwinner Syrah Blend** (*Central Coast, CA 62% Syrah, 27% Grenache, 11% Mourvedre*)
Pomegranate, raspberry, wild strawberry, hints of smoke and stone, and Grenache spice on the long finish and soft tannins.
- 780 **2013 Selby - Grenache** (*Dry Creek Valley, California*)
Bold flavors of cassis and cherry with notes of clove and nutmeg. Great acidity with soft tannins.
- 860 **2013 Vistalba - Malbec Blend** (*Mendoza, Argentina Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Bonarda*)
Lively and vibrant red fruits, smooth, velvety tannins, and hints of cocoa complement the good body and lengthy, elegant finish.
- 861 **2011 Herdade do Esporão Red Reserva** (*Alentejo, Portugal Alicante Bouschet, Aragonez, Trincadeira & Cabernet*)
Esporão estate history goes back to the XIII century. Their reserva shows its unique blend of terroir exposed to the Atlantic breeze. Full body, ripe intense red and black fruit, dark cocoa and a very long finish. 12 months in oak.
- 778 **2014 Munt Roca Priorat** (*Spain, 60% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon*)
With ripe berry fruit and a peppery nose, the balanced palate shows sufficient acidity, structure, robust tannins and minerality.

RED WINES OVER \$90

- 700 **2012 Angela Estate Abbott Claim** (*Yamhill-Carlton, Oregon*)
A more masculine pinot noir. the wine is richly colored, savory and complex. Fruits tend to be darker such as plum skin, cassis and black cherry. \$98
- 832 **2012 Pago Ayles "3"** (*Spain 34% Garnacha, 33% Merlot, 34% Cabernet Sauvignon*)
A perfectly balanced, smooth, full bodied wine with ripe red fruit flavors, mineral and spicy aromas. \$98
- 833 **2013 Jané Ventura Sumoll** - (*Penedes, Spain*)
Intense ruby color with a bright rim. In the nose, the characteristic cherry aromas of the Sumoll are nicely integrated and balanced with balsamic notes and toast. In the palate it is extremely fresh with red fruits (cherry and raspberry) and balsamic notes of undergrowth and soft tannins. Balsamic and mineral notes appear in the after-taste. It has a long and pronounced finish. \$98
- 835 **2012 Tonti Family Wines-Old Vine Zinfandel** (*Russian River Valley, CA*)
Bright dark opaque garnet blue color with flavors of black raspberries, candied violets, bramble, with a touch of pepper. Tannic, crisp, dry full body and a warming. Complex, medium-length finish with firm tannins and moderate oak. \$98
- 848 **2014 Trefethen Dragon's Tooth-Malbec Blend** (*Napa Valley, CA 45% Malbec, 35% Petit Verdot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon*)
Aromas of blackberry and cracked pepper, with hints of cinnamon and other baking spices. The palate features flavors of red currant and wood smoke leading to a long, elegant finish. \$98
- 792 **2010 Dry Creek Vineyard Mariner Meritage - Magnum** (*Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma Cty, CA*) \$180
41% Cabernet Sauvignon, 41% Merlot, 7% Malbec, 6% Cabernet Franc, 5% Petit Verdot Opulent texture and ever-deepening layers of complex, juicy flavors in a smooth and seductive body.
